\*Just like we have multiple names (first names, last names, nick names, etc.), music notes do to. We've already learned how to give the notes *solfege* names (do, re, mi, etc.) and *value names* (whole, half, quarter, eighth, etc.). Now we are giving the notes *Treble Clef Letter Names*.
